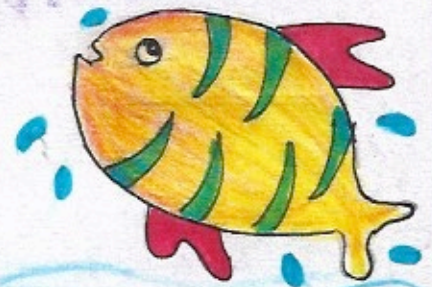
## Answer the following questions:
